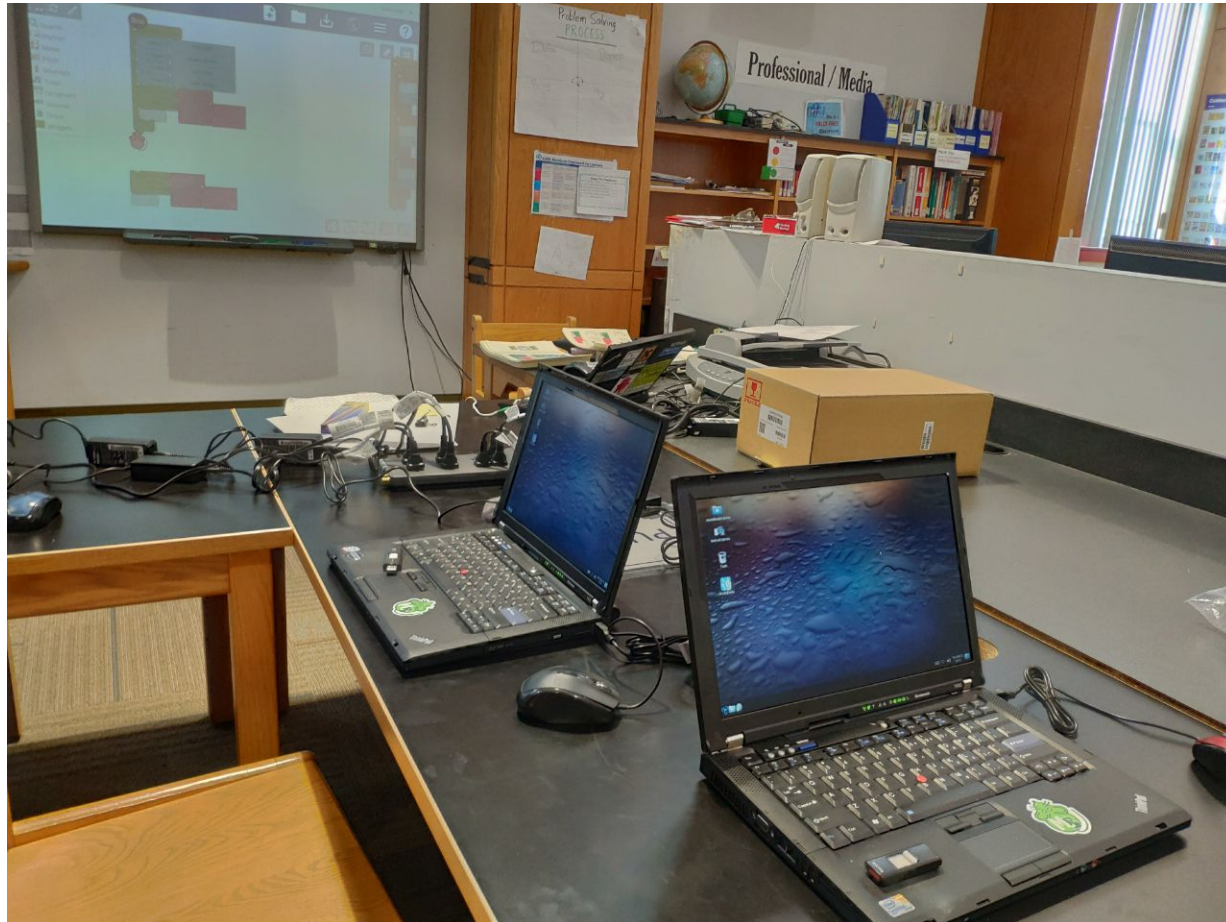

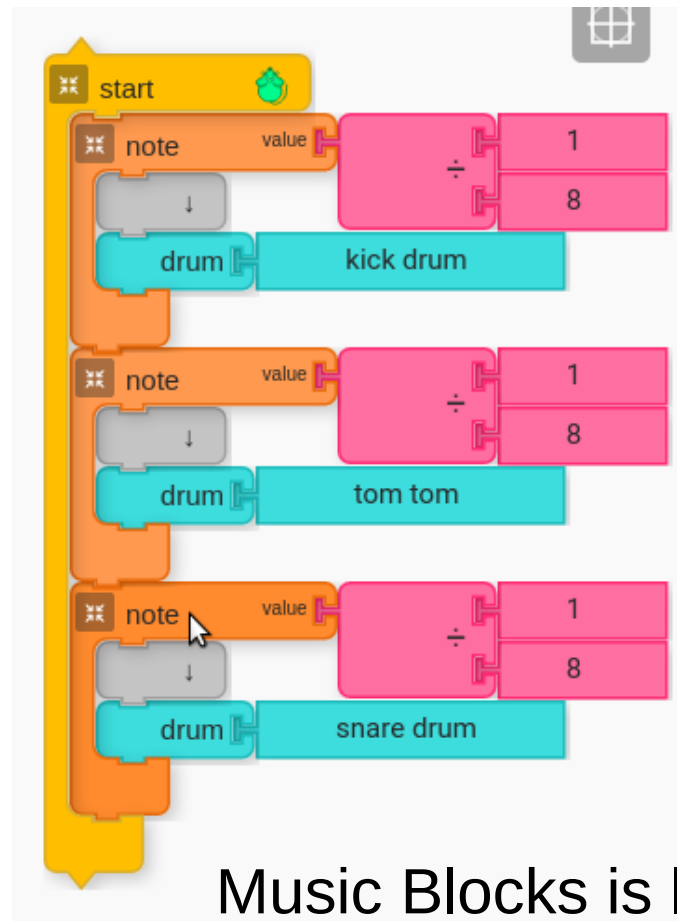

Music Blocks Visual Programming

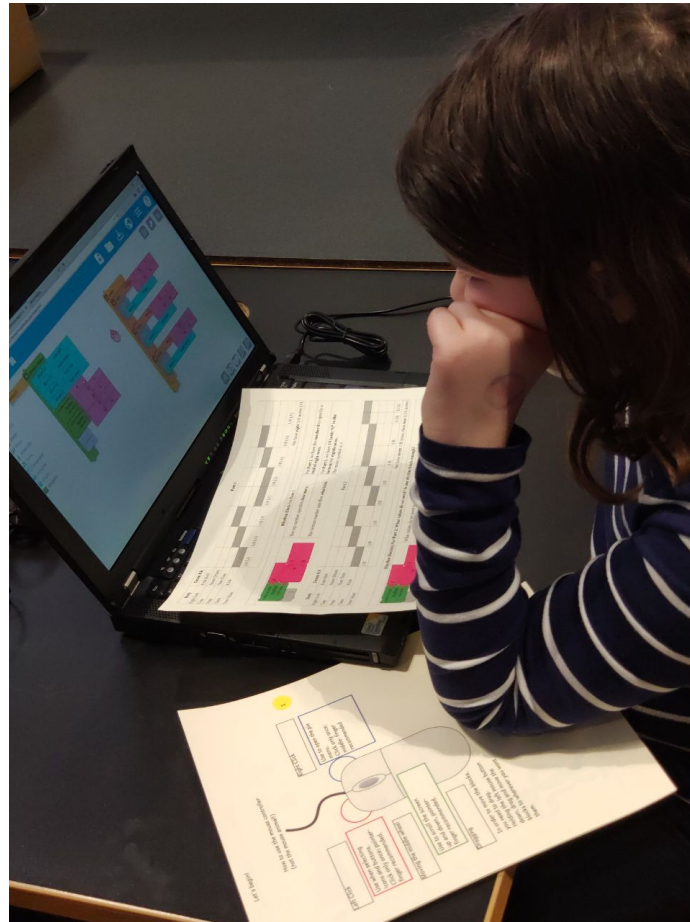

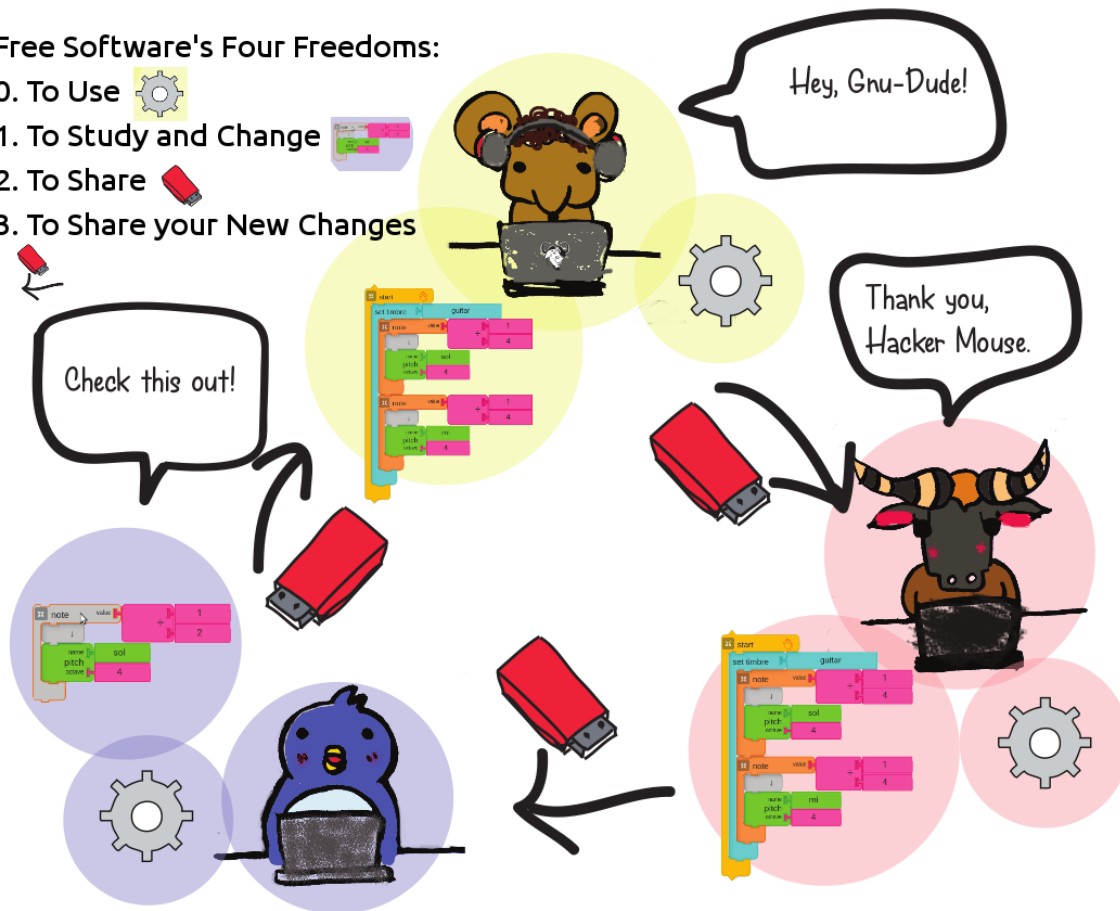
